WILHAUKS BEEF JERKEY FUNDRAISER



FIRST NATIONS INFORMATION UPDATE

Wisdom and Humility are the Seven Sacred Teachings that we have focused on over the last couple of months. Our grade 3 classes shared that wisdom is represented by the beaver because he uses his natural gift wisely for his survival. The students encouraged us to find our natural gifts and talents and use them to make the world a better place. The grade 4 classes shared that humility is represented by the wolf, who are social animals that live in packs. They work in cooperation with each other and for the greater good of the pack. The grade 4 students reminded us that we need to think of others before thinking of ourselves. The final teaching, Truth, represented by the turtle, will be shared in May. Our next Fort Saskatchewan First Nations, Metis, and Inuit Family Gathering will be taking place on May 28th at West Rivers Edge Pavilion. We look forward to seeing our Indigenous families there to celebrate and have a time of connection.
